- 3. Provide documented proof of blindness (20/200) or visual impairment (20/70) from an Optometrist or Ophthalmologist.**
- 4. Provide proof of legal residency in Texas.**
- 5. Applicants must meet all standards required and be accepted for admission to their chosen university. Please note priority will be given to San Antonio residents.**
- 6. Applicant must have a 2.5 GPA or higher.**
- 7. Complete Release of Information Form.**
