Submittal Instructions

The Desk and Derrick Club of San Antonio is awarding scholarships to graduating seniors from San Antonio area public high schools, home schools, or charter schools. Students must be planning to attend a four-year accredited college or university in the 2017-2018 school year.

Applicants will be judged on financial need, community service, evidence of leadership/citizenship and academic record (minimum 3.0 GPA in high school). Preference will be given to those with an interest in the Energy Industry.

Each scholarship recipient must take on a course load equivalent to full-time status. If at the end of their freshman year the recipient has maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average, they will be eligible to reapply for an additional scholarship. The value of the additional scholarship will be at the discretion of the Desk and Derrick Board. See official rules below:

- 1. Each scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior from a San Antonio area public high school, home school, or charter school. Desk and Derrick members, as well as their families are eligible to apply.
- 2. Each scholarship recipient will be chosen by the Scholarship Committee made up of members of the Desk and Derrick Club of San Antonio.
- 3. The following criteria must be submitted to be considered: high school transcript, personal essay, and two written recommendations by principal, counselors, teachers and/or community/club leaders. Applicant will also submit a detailed application available on Desk and Derrick's website http://saddc.org/. Neatness and ability to follow instructions are very important and will also be considered by the selection committee.
- 4. High school transcripts and references are to be sealed and included in the packet with application to the address provided.
- 5. Student must be planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited four-year college or university.
- 6. Upon receipt of student's college admittance statement and tuition and fees statement for their first semester, a check for the amount of the scholarship will be issued to the student.
- 7. If applicant is related to or known by any member on the selection committee, the committee member shall be ineligible to vote for that applicant. The Desk and Derrick of San Antonio is an equal opportunity non-profit organization; and no preference will be made to race, creed, nationality or religious preference of the scholarship applicants.
- 8. Each scholarship recipient and their counselor will be notified by a Desk and Derrick scholarship committee member by Telephone and written correspondence through regular mail or e-mail.
- 9. Each scholarship recipient and parent(s) will be invited as guests of the Desk and Derrick Club of San Antonio to a regularly scheduled, monthly meeting at the Petroleum Club to be officially introduced to the membership.



- 10. Student applicant understands that the scholarship is to be used for college tuition and fees, books and/or college living expenses. According to the IRS, contacted April 2, 2001, and according to 1099 Section, page 24 (Miscellaneous) Desk and Derrick does not have to submit a 1099 to the student as long as it is for regular studies. A 1099 needs to be submitted only if the scholarship is given to be used as wages, such as studies, preparation of papers, or specific project, etc.
- All scholarship applications must be mailed with sealed references and transcript to the following address: Desk and Derrick Club of San Antonio; Attention: Kathy Johnson; P.O. Box 782228, San Antonio, Texas 78278. Submissions must be postmarked by Saturday April 30, 2016. Any applications received after the due date and any incomplete applications will not be considered NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 12. Notification letters will be sent to recipients of the scholarships by May 15, 2017. Applicants who have not received notification from the scholarship committee by May 29, 2017 have not been selected as recipients of the scholarships.
