RESOLUTION OF THE STOCKDALE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD REGARDING HAZARDOUS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, Education Code 42.155(d) allows the Board of Trustees of Stockdale Independent School District to obtain supplemental state funding for transporting regular, otherwise ineligible students who live within two miles of their school but who would be subject to hazardous traffic conditions if they walked to school;

WHEREAS, the TEA handbook on School Transportation allotments requires the Board to adopt language providing the definition of hazardous traffic conditions applicable to the District and identifying the specific hazardous areas for which such funding is requested;

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges the Education Code 42.155 (d) provisions stating that a hazardous condition exists where no walkway is provided and students must walk along or cross freeway or expressway, an underpass, an overpass or a bridge, and uncontrolled major traffic artery, and industrial or commercial area, or another comparable condition;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Stockdale Independent School District has defined hazardous traffic conditions in the same manner as state in Education Code 42.155 (d) and has identified the following specific hazardous areas in which such conditions exist:

- 1. The blocks bounded by Highway 123 South, Mayer Street, South Eleventh Street, East Street, Twelfth Street, and Business 87 East
- 2. The blocks bounded by Highway 123 North, East Wheeler Street, West Free Timber Street, and West Wheeler Street.
- 3. The blocks bounded by West Main Street crossing Highway 87/97 and South Cemetery Street.
